When will IK resume?

In light of the recent increases in Kentucky COVID cases and additional restrictions announced recently, we think it is wise to delay our plans to add childcare to our Sunday morning gatherings. Where will I serve once Forward as One begins?

If you currently serve with Immanuel Kids, you will be contacted with your Forward as One volunteer placement at least four weeks before Forward as One begins. The pastoral lead team asked that we request the following commitments from the volunteers:

- 1. Blue Hall Sunday School Serve every Sunday for one year
- 2. Green Hall Sunday School Serve 3 months on/3 months off for one year
- 3. Green Hall Worship Service Serve 1 week on/5 weeks off at least one year
- 4. Substitutes Serve flexibly at least 1 week on/5 weeks off at least one year

As we move toward one service together, let's ponder Scripture that reveals the inclusion of children in the corporate worship of God. What a gift to have a church that encourages families to bring children to hear the preached Word, pray for one another, and sing to our great God!

WEEK 1

READ Hebrews 10:39

ASK What are the two types of actions and the results of those actions?

REPEAT Those who have faith preserve their souls!

PRAY Help us to not shrink back, but to have faith in You.

WEEK 2

RFAD Hebrews 11:1

ASK What is faith?

REPEAT Faith is the conviction of things not seen.

PRAY God, give us the gift of faith.

WEEK 3

READ Hebrews 11:2

ASK What is commendation?

REPEAT People of old had faith in God.

PRAY Thank you for giving faith to people in so many generations.

SING Hebrews 11:1

WEEK 4

READ Hebrews 10:39–11:3

ASK How were things created?

REPEAT God created the universe by His powerful word!

PRAY Make our faith grow as we see the things you have made.

SING Hebrews 11:1

FAMILY WORSHIP REMINDERS

Adapted from Donald S. Whitney's "Family Worship"

Be brief. 5-10 minutes is ideal.

Be regular. Daily is best. These provided devotionals are meant to get your week started and reinforce what children are learning in Immanuel Kids.

Be flexible. Sometimes life means family worship happens in the car instead of the home. Be flexible in location, but don't let flexibility lead to inconsistency.
